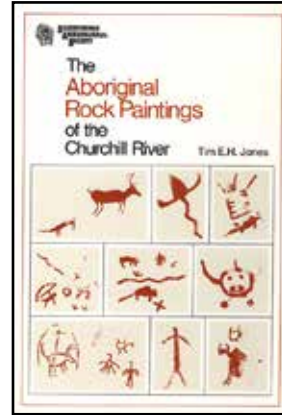
This large format volume details an event that helped spur the young Canadian government to establish the North West Mounted Police on the until then lawless prairies. A collection of newspaper accounts, witness statements and other reminiscences are used to retell this tragic story. The book includes detailed reports on the most recent archaeological investigations in the vicinity of the massacre site.

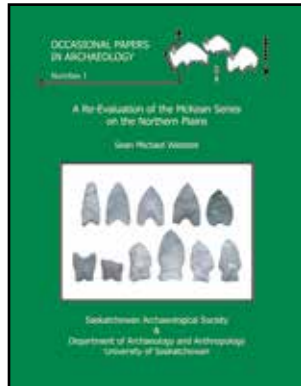

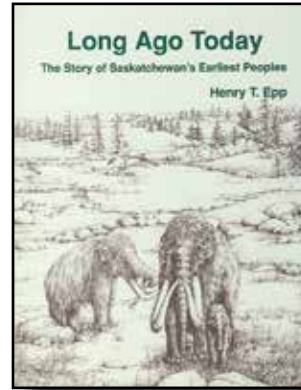

This doctoral thesis examines in detail the broad geographical range of people associated with the McKean Series (about 4400-3200 BP), pulling together new and existing information from archaeological investigations. Studies show that occupations were short-term summer campsites, with a reliance on a diversity of plant and animal species.



Long Ago Today is a book about Saskatchewan's and western Canada's earliest peoples and their lifestyles, and about archaeology, which helps bring them to life today. It provides a prehistory of Saskatchewan, a series of fictional stories set in the past, and how people can learn more about early people.
