

# Zenon Pohorecky Memorial Bursary

The Zenon Pohorecky Memorial Bursary is an annual bursary awarded to students enrolled in Archaeology or Anthropology at the University of Saskatchewan in Saskatoon or students enrolled in the Departments of Indigenous Languages, Arts and Culture, or Indigenous Education at the First Nations University of Canada (Regina, Saskatoon or Northern campus).

This endowment fund was established by the Saskatchewan Archaeological Society (SAS) through the generosity of multiple donors in the name of the late Dr. Zenon Pohorecky – an academic, activist, artist, and archaeologist.

Students must be enrolled in their second year or later with an acceptable academic standing (minimum average of 70%). **Applicants should provide a transcript of their marks and proof of enrolment as well as a brief statement of need and of career aspirations.**

**BURSARY AMOUNT: \$500.00**

Students interested in applying for this bursary should contact the Saskatchewan Archaeological Society for an application. **All interested applicants must submit their applications to the SAS office by March 31<sup>st</sup>.**
