Two SAS Collections Assistants will help the Saskatchewan Archaeological Society identify, catalogue, and curate avocational archaeology collections. The intent is to share information with communities and to complete any necessary Saskatchewan Archaeology Resource Record forms.

Qualifications:

- Candidates should have experience in archaeological method and theory, preferably with a focus on historical or fur trade archaeology.
- Candidates should be able to identify Saskatchewan archaeological artifacts.
- Ideally, the candidate will have completed, or be near completion of a Bachelor's degree in archaeology or another closely related discipline such as Museum Studies, History or Indigenous Studies.
- Computer competency in Word, Access, Excel and Outlook is required and experience with a database program would be an asset.
- This project involves a human-interest component and applicants should have experience and be comfortable working with diverse audiences and public speaking.

The Saskatchewan Archaeological Society encourages candidates from the Government of Canada's job equity groups (i.e., women, people with disabilities, Aboriginal people, and members of visible minorities) to self-identify. The SAS fosters a safe and welcoming environment for self-identification.

Young Canada Works-Summer Jobs eligibility requirements require that candidates be 30 years of age or younger at the start of the position and be a current student who is returning to school full time in the fall of 2021. A background reference check will be required, and the successful candidate will need to hold a valid driver's license as well as provide a Criminal Record Check with the Vulnerable Sector.
